





HISTORY OF THE BELLAMY AWARD

The Bellamy Award honors the free public school system in this nation and those schools which are alert to the true meaning of the Pledge of Allegiance. The Bellamy Award was devised to identify Francis Bellamy as the author of the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America. It was established by Miss Margarette S. Miller, Portsmouth, Virginia, originator and director of the National Bellamy Award.

AN HONOR AND A CHALLENGE.

Ten outstanding factors won the Bellamy

- Principal's Proficiency—Mr. W. H. Millsaps, Central's conscientious and loyal administrator, has presented an excellent image of the school, staff, and alumni.
- Freedom Foundation Awards—In the past ten years, Central
 has received eight of the annual awards which are given for outstanding display of patriotism.
- CHMAQUE Brochure—Central High Means All-round Quality Education is a pamphlet sent to area junior high school students.
- Alumni—Central's active alumni association promotes scholarship awards and projects for the improvement of the school.
- ROTC and Girls' Battalion—"These units develop patriotism, respect for authority, and qualities of leadership."
- Bible Classes—These classes place emphasis upon the contribution of the Bible to history, art, literature, and music.
- Teachers—Central's teachers have an unusually outstanding record of long terms of service.
- Public Relations—Business-Industry-Education Days and community projects, such as the theme, "Improving Americanism," are examples of effective public relations programs.



Mathematics



Business Education

The Business Education Department has designed its program to meet the needs of all the students.

For those who plan to secure a vocational competence, excellent training is offered for secretarial, bookkeeping, clerical, or stenographic positions.

For those who plan to go to college, courses are included which give valuable basic training for their work there.

Lastly, for all students, the department provides a non vocational education which creates an appreciation and understanding of the business world.



Guidance

Guidance is an organized program through which we help boys and girls to understand and to use wisely the educational, the vocational, personal potentialities, and the opportunities which they have, or can develop. With such a concern, a wholesome climate should prevail for all students to develop in a positive manner. Counselors are willing to assist students with all school problems. Mr. Hale is the director of the program at Central, and Mrs. Okrasinski is the assisting counselor. Guidance services focus upon individual pupils. These services are thought of as organized activities designed to give systematic aid to pupils to assist in their learning about the large complex and changing world of opportunities.

Art

The objectives are to give the student a special means for personal and individual statement, thus helping to increase his realization of his own worth as one human being capable of doing something well and responsible for using well his peculiar abilities. They furnish the pupil with the special vocabulary of art: color, line, form, light, dark, paint, brush, pencil, paper, clay, stone, metal, cotton, silk, wool, and man-made fibers. It helps to arouse the imagination to the point where the pupil will strive to put into form his own ideas, rather than turn to "the book" for something to do, They furnish only what technical skill the pupil may need to express his idea. It gives some experience in a number of art areas so that the pupil may have some basis for choice in further art study.



History

The History Department, led by Mrs. Virginia Skates, offers a number of courses in order to improve the quality of citizenship and to help students understand national and world problems.

Tennessee history is taught in the seventh grade, and United States history is taught in the eighth grade. Bible is offered in grades nine through twelve. World history is open to sophomore, junior, and senior students; and American history is required in the senior year.



Music

Our Music Department is one of the best, with opportunities for all in almost any field of music in which one wishes to participate. By participation, we broaden ourselves and learn to distinguish that which is good and at the same time study music that will enrich our lives.



Home Economics

Students in the Home Economics Department get acquainted with the problems met by the entire family: physical, social, material, and emotional.

Consideration of individual problems such as reducing diets, personal grooming, and proper styling of clothes, adds to the self confidence of the individual.

One of the basic objectives of home economics is to raise the standards of home living. This purpose is provided by a program which includes budgeting, management, child care, clothing, planning, and preparation for nutritious and balanced meals.



Industrial Arts

The Industrial Arts Department is led by Mr. J. J. Fletcher. This department includes mechanical drawing, woodworking, printing, and auto mechanics with a major offered in each. The purpose of this department is to give students knowledge and guidance in practical skills useful for future occupations. This year there are three hundred fifteen students enrolled in these useful courses.



Mathematics

The mathematics curriculum consists of those courses, activities, and units of instruction designed to contribute to the common and specialized mathematics needs of secondary-school pupils. The curriculum places particular stress on developing accuracy and facility in the use of computational processes in practical situations. Provisions are made for pupils to develop skills and abilities in the mathematics areas of geometry, graphic representation and interpretation, elementary analysis, and scientific thinking.



Science

The Science Department is composed of seven instructors with Mr. J. Arlie Hoodenpyl as head. Within the department there is a composite one hundred and two years of teaching experience. Included in the department are general science, biology, chemistry, physics, and photography. During the present school year there are eight hundred fifty students enrolled within this department, whose purpose is to instruct the students in scientific knowledge and its practical application.



Social Science

The chief purpose of education is to train every student to become the best citizen he is capable of being. The social science subjects have the above purpose. They cannot achieve this aim entirely; they contribute to the achievement of it. Civics, economics, sociology, and psychology are comparatively new subjects in the curriculum. They are enriching subjects. They seek to acquaint the students with background and environment and to contribute to his maximum usefulness in our society.

Foreign Languages

In our Foreign Language Department we are trying to develop facility in reading and writing the language, together with a more realistic approach to understanding and speaking the language.

To achieve the latter, the role of the language laboratory in the instructional program looms increasingly important, since it provides regular practice in listening and repeating the foreign language as presented by educated native speakers.

Listening practice is intended to lead to the ability to understand the spoken language, and the language laboratory is of real value in attaining this goal, not to mention its value as a means of motivating the student in his language efforts.





Languages-English

The English Department, composed of thirteen instructors, offers courses to meet the needs of all students in the school. In addition to the basic courses in composition, vocabulary, and drill, special features of the department are courses in reading, journalism, creative writing, speech, and dramatics. Both school publications, the Digest and the Champton are sponsored by the English department.


Speech

CENTRAL 6; JOHNSON CITY 21

Central opened their season this year with a loss to Johnson City. It was Johnson City's first victory over a Red Etter coached team in six meetings. After losing their first two games the Pounders decided it was time to start winning. The first victim of the Pounders wrath was their cross town rival City. The only City touchdown came during the first half. The rest of the ball game belonged to the Pounders all the way. Among the stars for the Pounders was sophomore quarterback Larry Shelly, who completed two touchdown passes. Others who helped the scoreboard change for Central were senior halfback Gary Quarles, sophomore fullback Phil Lewis, senior end Leon Fraley, halfback Bill Harless, and captain Johnny Slaten. Extra points after touchdown were made by Harless and Bryant Millsaps.

CENTRAL 0; KINGSPORT 6

Central lost a heart breaking ballgame against the number one rated Kingsport Indians in Kingsport. The only score of the game came during the second quarter of play. After a fifty-yard drive and an end zone pass, the scoring was over. The Pounders invaded the Indians territory only twice. The most outstanding offensive performers for Central were fullback Phil Lewis and halfback Gary Quarles.

CENTRAL 21: ELIZABETHTON 7

Central's second taste of victory came during the game with the Elizabethton Cyclones. Central's quarterback, Larry Shelly, completed three of six passes for 117 yards and one touchdown. During the second period Ken Pack went up the middle from the nine to score after Jerry Blancett took a twenty-five yard pass from Shelly. The third score came after a 55-yard run from Bill Harless. The only Cyclone touchdown came in the last minute and 54 seconds of the game.

CENTRAL 6; BRADLEY 7

Central's greatest rival, the Bradley Bears, shadowed the Pounders by one point. This was one of the most exciting games of the season. Larry Shelly sparkled by completing 14 of 23 passes for 155 yards. The Central touchdown came from an end zone pass from Shelly to Quarles. The extra point was missed by Central but not for the Bears who scored on a 45-yard run by David Cawood. Ed Becker, the Bears extra point specialist, booted the decisive point of the Bears game.

CENTRAL 7; BRAINERD 6

Brainerd gave Central one of the nearest most hard-fought games of the year. Brainerd scored first in the third period. The point after touchdown was missed. During the fourth quarter the hopes of the Pounders looked thin until sophomore quarterback, Larry Shelly, completed a pass to halfback, Ken Pack, who made the touchdown. Central's Purple Pounders matched the dead eye passing of Q.B. Gregg McCall with spectacular long-distance runs, bringing the Irish to their knees and capturing the H.I.L. Championship. The running for the Pounders was done by fullback Phil Lewis and halfback Ken Pack. Pack and Lewis contributed long fourth quarter touchdown runs that put Central out of reach for the Irish. The outstanding quarterback for the Irish, Greg McCall, kept the Central defense on their toes. The winning game for the Pounders proved to be a chilly but exciting one.

Central's Pounders ripped back 67 yards with the opening kickoff but never got past the Bobcats 20-yard line after that as Central fell to Knox Central 21-7. After Central's T.D., that was gained by Gary Quarles, Carl Dunn and Marion Thompson sparked a drive for the tying touchdown. During the second half Knox Central didn't seem to have

a bit of trouble with the Ponders defense. Robert Watson of Knox Central found the second Bobcat paydirt. The third Bobcat T.D. came on a 60-yard run by Thompson. Top defensive players for the Pounders were Phil Lewis and Bill Harless






