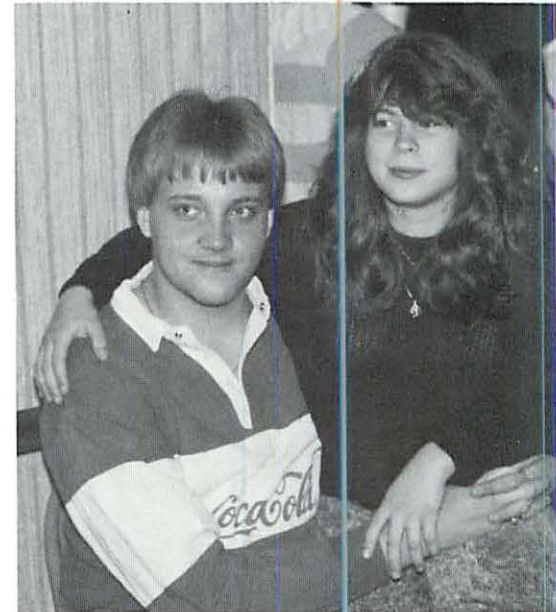
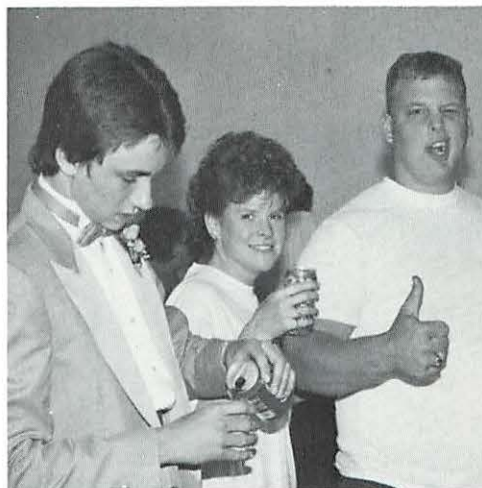
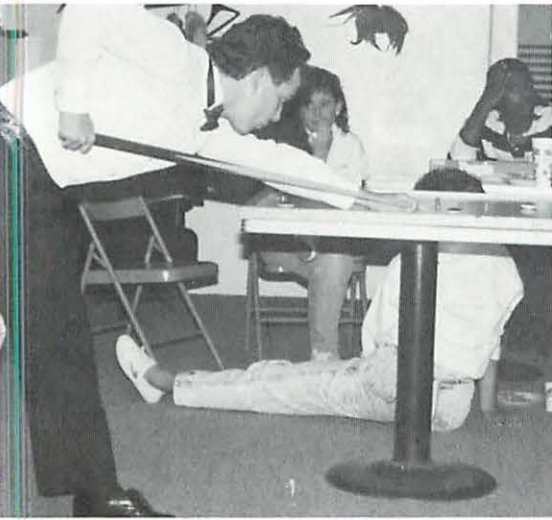








# AFTER PROM PARTY

Be like the Bumblebee in the poem by Bob Gannaway:

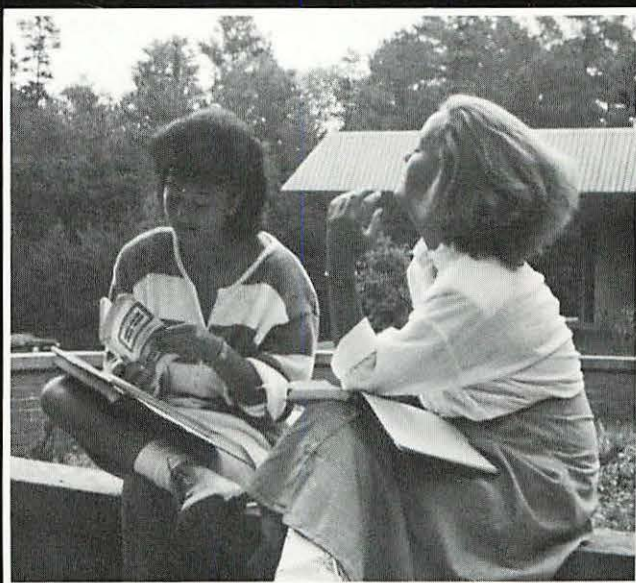
